



Introduction to Acrylic Painting

Paints -Basic starter set (at least primary colours + black + white)

- Titanium White
- Cadmium Red (or similar warm red)
- Alizarin Crimson (or similar cool red)
- Ultramarine Blue (cool blue)
- Phthalo Blue (warm blue)
- Cadmium Yellow (warm yellow)
- Lemon Yellow (cool yellow)
- Burnt Umber / Raw Umber (earth tones)

Brushes:

- Flat brush (medium size, e.g., size 8–12)
- Round brush (medium, e.g., size 6–8)
- Small detail brush (size 0–2)
- Large flat or wash brush (for backgrounds)

Surfaces

- Acrylic painting paper pad OR primed canvas/canvas board (A3 size recommended for class)

Palette & Mixing Tools

- Plastic or wooden palette (a disposable palette pad also works)
- Palette knife for mixing

Other Essentials

- Water jar (for rinsing brushes)
- Rag or paper towels
- Pencil & eraser (for sketching outlines)
- Masking tape (to create clean edges if desired)
- Apron or old shirt (to protect clothing)

Optional Extras

- Spray bottle (to keep paints moist)
- Gel medium or slow-dry medium (to extend drying time and experiment with texture)
