Please buy one watercolour set of your choosing, one set of brushes, and one watercolour pad of paper. The materials listed in 'other' are also required.

Note: **Cold press** watercolour paper has a texture, bumpy surface and tends to be the most popular choice for most watercolourists.

Hot press watercolour paper is smooth and has very little texture. It's ideal for artists who love detail work and smooth washes.

Hot press is preferred by artists who need precision and fine detail in their artwork.

Note: Good places to buy reasonably priced art supplies are Red Dot, Officeworks, Kmart and Amazon. If you wish to invest in materials that are of a higher quality, Jacksons is suitable.
