

Teen Pottery Class – Ages 13+

This class is a great opportunity for teens aged 13 and over to develop their pottery skills, get creative with clay and learn in a relaxed and supportive environment.

WHAT TO BRING

Please make sure your teen brings the following to each class:

- **Towel** – to cover themselves while working at the pottery wheel
- **Closed-in shoes**
- **Old or practical clothing** – please don't wear your best clothes, and avoid flowing garments
- **Hair ties/headband/scarf** – long hair must be secured
- **P2 or N95 face mask** – required for sanding
- **Safety glasses** – required for sanding

COSTS

There are additional costs associated with this class - Firing and Clay

Clay is \$25.00 a bag and can be purchased from us. On average, students use a bag of clay a term. However, this is completely dependent on how many items you make.

Firing is charged according to the **size of the pot and the type of firing required**. Each piece will generally be fired twice. As an example, a typical-sized cup would cost approximately **\$6–\$8 for both firings**.

Payment for firing and clay can be made as you go. An **EFTPOS machine is available in the pottery hall**, and EFTPOS is the preferred payment method. A firing slip will need to be completed for each piece submitted for firing.

POTTERY SAFETY AND PROCEDURES

Attached to this email is the **Canning Arts Group Pottery Booklet**, which contains our safety and operating procedures.

Please take the time to read the booklet carefully, preferably **before classes commence**, so that both parents and students are familiar with the requirements.
